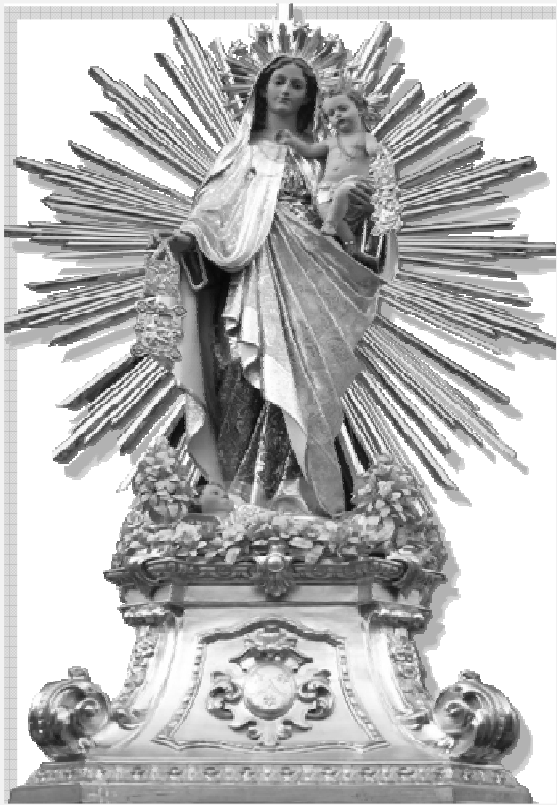

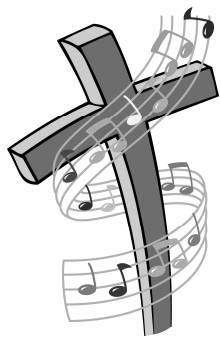
The Feast of O.L.M.C

Music Notes...

Since Vatican II, Popes Paul VI, John Paul II and Benedict XVI have often referred to the term, 'New Evangelization'. What does this term mean? According to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, the 'New Evangelization' is defined as a re-energized effort to bring back all those who have drifted away from their catholic faith.



One area of particular interest to me is the drifting away of youth from the Catholic Church.

As music director, I find music ministry to be a fantastic tool to carry out so much of our call toward the New Evangelization. The ministry itself has led me to believe that the youth have drifted away from the faith not so much through their own fault but as a result of a deep misunderstanding of their own faith.

As choir members, cantors and instrumentalists alike, we the members of our church's music ministry have the power to lure back those who have drifted away. We have the power to go outside of the narrow confines of the loft itself and into the lofty world of the outside. One valuable lesson I have learned: contrary to what many believe, the youth WANT God. They just need shepherds to guide them back toward Him and to tell them that God loves them.

The youth are such an important part of our church and they are our future. As a case in point, soon our junior choir will be offered an opportunity to go out and bring our music of hope to Nursing Homes.

In addition, we now have two junior choristers who are currently working with me to become junior cantors and who may potentially join me in cantoring for the St. Joseph's Hospital Radio Mass which broadcasts to thousands of home-bound individuals across NJ, PA, CT and NY.

In short, the message is simple. Our youth want GOD in their lives. We need to continue fostering our junior music ministry members and our efforts to expand. We must not be afraid to call on those from the outside. It is our future, our calling and our duty. We are all in this together. Let us bring God to them so they in turn, can bring God to others both today and tomorrow.
