Hi Friends. Today, I would like to talk to you about our Hymn Board. It has been two years since we accepted it as a special gift from the pastor of Holy Family Church. I hope it has been a good aide for all of you. Each Sunday you notice the board has two columns of numbers. The right column contains the main hymns that will be sung for that Mass, i.e., the gathering, preparation, communion and recessional. The left column contains the psalm and/or the gospel acclamation along with the post-communion hymn and Gloria, if applicable.

I would encourage you to make good use of our Hymn Board by turning to the hymn prior to the cantor's announcement. This allows you to focus on the organ introduction which sets the tempo, rhythm and general mood of the piece. It will assist you in singing with greater ease and effectiveness.
