Dear Parish Family,

Beginning this month of October, we will be celebrating a monthly special Mass for the Religious Education children and their parents and/or guardians. Aside from your active participation at our daily and weekly masses, I ask you all to join us for our Novena to the Infant of Prague every Tuesday evening at 7:30 pm, our Parish Adoration every First Friday of the Month beginning at 8:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., the recitation of the rosary after the daily Mass and the Novena to the Our Lady of Mt. 
