Dear Parish Family,

With the passing of Labor Day holiday, we are resuming our busy parish schedule. I am pleased to tell you some of the plans I have for the upcoming months. First, I'd like to meet with our existing ministries, discuss areas where we can improve and any suggestions or concerns which may need to be addressed. Second, I'd like to revive some important programs or establish new ones as necessary. I'd like to solicit your suggestions and recommendations as part of a "program of activities" intended for implementation within the coming weeks and months.

Third, to Nick Molinaro for his assistance in overseeing their installation. Fourth, to the Carpenters' Association, who through their effort and skill, professionally installed them and, lastly, to all who donated money for this project. Thank you for your generosity. I was quite pleased to see our common effort result in such a wonderful completion of this project.

Devotions like praying the rosary, novenas, processions, adorations, etc. are an integral part of our Catholic tradition. Simply being a follower of Christ is not enough to live a complete life. You must be constantly growing in your understanding and in your connection to God. To help us grow more and deepen our faith, we are planning to introduce a weekly adoration for our parish starting sometime in October.
