## Music Notes

Out of all of the singing we do at mass, which prayer or song do you think is the most powerful? Some may say, the Sanctus (Holy, Holy) where we join forces with the choirs of angels, the saints and all the heavenly hosts in proclaiming God's glory. Still others may point to the Gloria where we give glory to God as the highest realm of being. Finally, some may say, the recessional hymn where we are sent forth by God to go home using a different path than the one you came.

These different songs are all very powerful. But what about the Psalm? Friends, the Psalms come from the Book of Psalms in the Bible.

The Psalms are poetic and rhythmic expressions of our own story and our daily joys and struggles in our relationship with God. For example, Psalm 51 "Be Merciful O Lord, for I have Sinned" expresses our inner most remorse. Yet, we find light and hope in knowing God's infinite mercy.

The study of the Psalms is amazing and powerful. I encourage you to learn more about them. I recommend a book entitled, "The Psalms - Songs of Faith and Praise" by Gregory J. Dolan, OSB. You can buy a copy on amazon.com or paulistpress.com. Next mass, pay close attention to the Psalm. Try to relate to the story in that Psalm and use it as your personal prayer to God. The Psalms ARE OUR STORY. Let them become, 'YOU'.
